



## Early Childhood Educator: Posting

### **Job Summary**

We are looking for an Early Childhood Educator to join our Child Care staff team in our Infant/Toddler program. In this role, you will be part of SNP's dynamic and inclusive team. In addition to planning and implementing a program, tasks of ECE include providing children with a developmentally appropriate, fun, safe and healthy environment. Our organization supports positive social interaction and well-being of families and individuals, and encourages our staff to take part in opportunities for growth and development that are relevant in their work at SNP. As our employee's life-work balance is important to us, all of our permanent employees are offered paid personal time-off in addition to their regular vacation time. ### **Job Responsibilities**

As an Early Childhood Educator, you will be required to develop, evaluate and adjust programming in cooperation with the other child care staff and manager; communicate with families effectively; assist in maintaining children's records, our play spaces, etc. Light housekeeping is a part of the role, as is some documentation, staff meeting attendance, and ongoing professional development.
